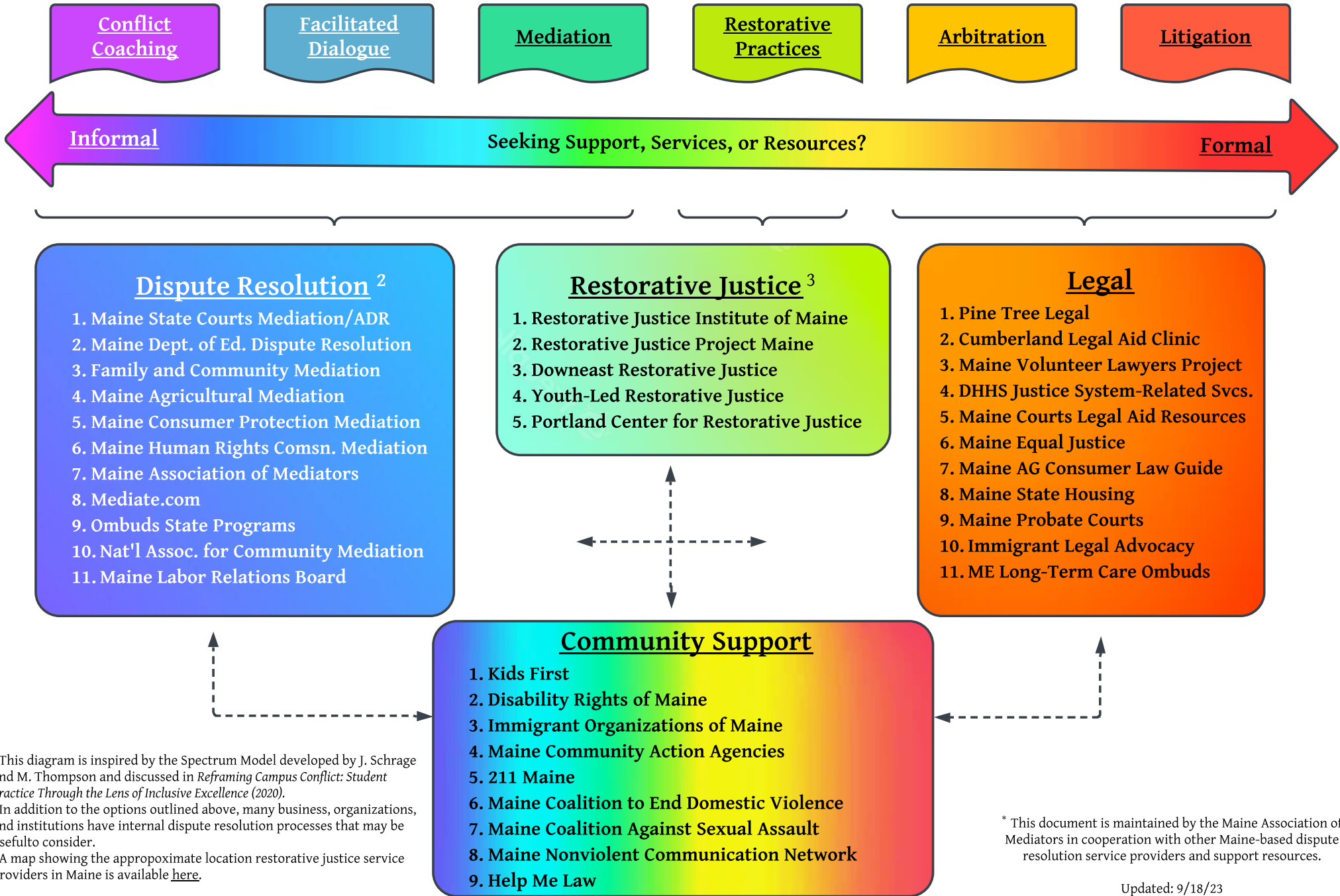




Dispute Resolution Service Providers and Support Resources in Maine *

When residents of Maine experience conflict, there are many options to consider. This diagram¹ illustrates the broad range of service providers and support resources available in Maine, including those providing help with informal interventions like conflict coaching and facilitated dialogue to those assisting with more formal methods like arbitration and litigation. Each approach can be supplemented by assistance from numerous community support organizations, including those highlighted below.
